Rape & Women	
<ul> <li>Surah 4:34 says, "As to those women on whose part ye fear disloyalty and ill-conduct, admonish them, refuse to share their beds, beat them."</li> <li>Surah 2:282 says that a woman's witness is equal to half of a man's "because of the deficiency of a woman's mind."</li> <li>Men are Permitted to Have 4 wives.</li> <li>Hadith 1:28 - Hell is mostly full of women who are ungrateful to their husbands.</li> <li>Muhammad permitted the rape of women captured in battle.</li> <li>Girls who have not reached puberty can be "married" (Implied by Surah 65:4)</li> <li>While in his 50's, Muhammad married a girl who was 6, but waited until she was 9 to consummate the relationship.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Exodus 22:16–17 - Seduction led to sex; marriage.</li> <li>Deuteronomy 22:23–24 - Consensual Sex; Death for both</li> <li>Deuteronomy 22:25-27 - Rape; Death for rapist</li> <li>Deuteronomy 22:28–29 - Similar to, and an expansion of Exodus 22:16–17</li> <li>Galatians 3:28 - There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor femalefor all of you are one in Christ Jesus.</li> <li>How God sees women and how Jews saw women are different</li> </ul>
Salvation	

- No guaranteed salvation, save for dying in jihad (Sura 61:10 and Sura 9:111)
- · God, man, hell, heaven, but no Mediator
- Allah does not love those who do not love him
- "To those who believe and do deeds of righteousness hath Allah promised forgiveness and a great reward," (Surah 5:9)
- Christ secured salvation for his chosen people and will never lose any the father gives to him.
- For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus. (1 Tim. 2:5)
- In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins. (1 John 4:10)
